REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about 08/23/23, Bastrop County will submit a request to the Texas Department of Agriculture (Department), Office of Rural Affairs for the release of 2022 Community Development Block Grant funds under Section 104(f) of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended, to undertake a project known as 2022 CDBG Bastrop County Sewer Improvements Project #CDV21-0322 to provide new sewer lines and hookups to residents in unincorporated residences on Stony Mont Dr from High Point Dr to Rock Point Dr and from Rock Mont Dr to Edge Rock Dr. **Project Description** Contractor shall install approximately one thousand four eighty-five linear feet (1,485 LF) of sewer line, four (4) manholes, residential connections, and all necessary appurtenances to include Administration services and Engineering costs. Funding: CDBG \$350,000; Matching funds from the Fund \$17,500. Total Estimated Project Cost: \$367,500.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

Bastrop County has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment; therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR). The ERR will be made available to the public for review electronically or by U.S. mail. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to Bastrop County. All comments received by 8/22/23 will be considered by Bastrop County prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Objections must be prepared and submitted via email in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to Bastrop County at melissa.kincaid@co.bastrop.tx.us. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing. Potential objectors should contact Bastrop County via email to verify the actual last day of the objection period.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

Bastrop County certifies to the Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA), Office of Rural Affairs that Gregory Klaus, in his capacity as County Judge, consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The Department's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows Bastrop County to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

The Texas Department of Agriculture will accept objections to its release of funds and Bastrop County's certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request, (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of Bastrop County (b) Bastrop County has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by the Department; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to Environmental Review Specialist, Texas Department of Agriculture by email at **CDBG_ENVReview@TexasAgriculture.gov**. Potential objectors should contact the TDA Environmental Review Specialist at **CDBG_ENVReview@TexasAgriculture.gov** to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
